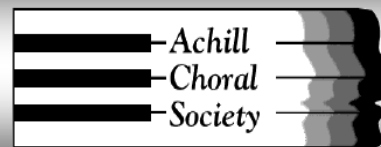


Achill Choral Society Presents Handel's Messiah
